How Art students are expected to utilise their study periods

Students are set targets, either as part of a whole class task or individually. This will have been discussed or issued by staff as part of a lesson or one to one tutorial. This discussion / tutorial may be documented either through notes in the student's folder, mark sheet, or a tutorial checklist or through a verbal discussion. Students should therefore use their study periods to work through this discussed work independently and develop their personal portfolio of work.

Some students may work more independently than others and of course, extend their ideas above what was outlined by staff. Students are encouraged to work in the department if they can during their study periods if they require use of specialist equipment, or use alternative college spaces / computers areas to work digitally.

As a guideline, we suggest that AS spend 3 hours a week and A2 spend 5 hours a week on their portfolio work, in addition to class time.
