

Health and Social Care

AS students have a total of 8 substantial pieces of coursework to complete before February half term. These are managed for students but it is a very tight schedule of lesson time, homework completion, draft versions and final versions. All AS students will have one or more pieces of on-going work in various stages of completion at any one time. During term 1 students will be working on unit 3 and will be progressing this both in lessons and in their own time. All students have electronic coversheets and instruction documents. In addition to lesson time staff are available in B9 in most blocks and over lunchtime to provide additional support if students need it. During term 2 students will be working on unit 2 with similar arrangements. Term 2 and 3 will be unit 1 which is exam based. For this key terms, exam past questions, mark schemes and revision mp3s are available electronically and should be used in addition to classroom material.

A2 students are more experienced and adept at using their study time. The same type of resources and materials are available to them together with tutorial support during some study periods and lunchtimes. All resources are available electronically, the year plan is slightly different in that they have an exam in January and the associated materials are made available earlier in the year. All health and social care students will always have a piece of work underway whether this be a draft or final version needing to be completed.
