

Human Biology

We aim to provide as many opportunities as possible to support all learners in achieving their full potential. This is just a quick a summary of what we do beyond the classroom.

Every **Thursday** there is the '**Human Biology Clinic**' where a mixture of one to one tutorials and large group tutorials take place. This is time set aside purely for supporting human biologists in their studies and there have been 14 of these so far this year. Students can also book time to see us in Monday-Wednesday lunch times providing we don't have any other commitments.

At the start of the year we give out a **term planner** which is a lesson by lesson break down of the course so that it can used it to plan ahead in case of any absences/missed lessons etc. All students know in September what they will be doing mid-March lesson by lesson. This term planner not only lists the topics that will be taught in class but also what homeworks will be set in the future allowing students to download next week's homework and ask for help on it before it has even been set.

After reviewing the homeworks in class, **video tutorials** are produced to help the students with the problems they have faced along with other additional support materials such as practice questions, mark schemes and model answers. All 14 of these produced since September are available to download from the **intranet**.

There are a further 8 video tutorials with **revision activities for the first exam** to help students develop there exam skills. These are also online ready for the second exam.

Every **past exam paper** that has been set since 2008 is available with mark scheme to download from the intranet to allow students to begin practicing the questions. This is a really important part of exam preparation.

We have just finished a 110 page '**eBook**' **revision guide** for the first human biology exam. This can be downloaded from the intranet as a PDF or you can email Dave for the interactive version. The eBook was written to work on any ePub reader such as smart phones, iPad, Kindle, Samsung Galaxy and it includes notes, links to webpages, video tutorials and assessment material, and of course it's free.
