

Performing Arts

- The students are provided with space to work in study periods : computer work stations, rehearsal rooms, practice rooms etc. so that group and individual practical and coursework assignments can be completed outside of class - all rooms have published timetables on the doors so that students can book space with the appropriate tutor
- Some of the rehearsal/recording time is scheduled by staff in the run-up to exams/coursework submissions - there is requirement for all students to work in ensemble/group situations during study periods as part of their course - the time commitment is made as explicit as possible
- There is a library of resources: books, magazines, DVDs etc. available for loan in all subject areas and students are encouraged to borrow these
- Enrichment activities at lunch-time or after college support the learning and students are encouraged to participate
- Students are invited to observe work in other classes at assessment and presentation times of the year
- Visits to concerts, dance-theatre and plays are arranged by staff
- Visitors are brought in to deliver talks and run workshops
